In particular, the main aim of the proposed study is to develop a system of ethics in research, which would support funding bodies to constantly adapt governance frameworks so as to induce society-friendly, research and innovation.

	<ul> <li>evaluate the real benefit of IT tools used to address research misconduct;</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>investigate the number and variety of allegation in EU and other OECD counties and identify the percentages of cases where original suspicion is confirmed and led to some form of sanctions</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>provide an in-depth analysis of representative cases that will bring a socioeconomic and a psychological dimension which is critical to the design of effective responses</li> </ul>		
	assess the possibility to unify the codes, principles and methods at EU and international level		
	• study the options to support the self-regulation mechanisms with an adapted legal framework		
	At a second level, the proposed study aims to develop a multifaceted framework that will incorporate law and governance, codes and practices, technology and education, societal actors and institutions, and ensure that outcomes resulting from Responsible Research and Innovation will correspond to the needs of various societal actors and be suitable for society in the long run.
