Grand debate on Nutrition Security – a whole systems approach

Often the focus of the debate and research is limited to food security alone – however access to food and the consumption of safe and nutritious food are important aspects of this challenge that require attention.

The aim of the event is to bring together approximately100 leading researchers, policy makers and politicians to:

- Facilitate a dialogue between international and national stakeholders to deepen our understanding of the challenge we are facing in providing future generations with a sustainable and nutritious food supply thereby ensuring a healthy population.
- Identify the role that both JPIs and their MS can play in tackling this societal challenge through the articulation of the research questions that should be addressed both individually and collaboratively by the JPIs.

The structure of the event will be built around two interactive panel discussions which will focus on all aspects of food and nutrition security. Through engagement with the audience and web streaming with over 20 countries, the insights of a large community will be achieved. About FACCE-JPI and JPI HDHL

FACCE-JPI brings together 21 European countries and aims to "increase the value of national and EU R&D funding on agriculture, food security and climate change, by concerted and joint planning, implementation and evaluation of national research programmes".

The JPI HDHL brings together 23 European Member States, Canada and New Zealand and it aims



to understand the interplay of factors known to directly affect diet-related diseases, discover new relevant factors, mechanisms and strategies, as well as to contribute to the development of actions, policies, innovative products and diets, with the aim of reducing the burden of diet-related diseases. As part of their respective communication and international collaboration strategies, the two JPIs are preparing a daylong event.

Not only is it an exhibition but also a process, one of active participation among a large number of players around the theme of Feeding the Planet, Energy for Life.
